### 3. CIRCUIT INFORMATION



- Length: 340 metres
- Width (straights): 10 metres
- Width (bends): 15 metres
- Surface: Red gravel

#### **Safety**

- Run-off area in bends: 6 metres
  - Run-off area on straights: 5 metres
  - Safety fence equipped with go-kart tyres and full-height rubber kickboard
- 

#### **4. ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS**

The use of an environmental mat in the pits is compulsory.  
Environmental mats may be purchased at the Race Office for €20.  
Failure to comply will result in exclusion from practice and/or the meeting.

#### **5. ENTRIES**

Entries are determined according to the official heat schedule.  
All riders receive free access including two accompanying persons.

---

#### **6. RACE JACKETS**

Race jackets are supplied by the organiser.  
All riders must wear the race jackets during:

- Practice
- Press conferences
- All heats
- Prize-giving ceremony

No personal sponsor or advertisement may cover any part of the race jacket, except the shoulder straps.  
Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the relevant session or heat.

#### **7. PRACTICE**

##### **Free Practice:**

4 July 2026 – 12:00 hrs to 17:00 hrs  
Open to all classes in accordance with FMB regulations.

##### **Official Practice:**

5 July 2026 – 10:00 hrs to 11:00 hrs  
Each class: 1 session of 3 minutes.

Practice is NOT compulsory unless otherwise instructed by the Clerk of the Course.

## **8. TECHNICAL CONTROL**

### **Machine Examination:**

5 July 2026 – 09:00 hrs to 10:00 hrs

The use of a heat shield is compulsory.

Fuel will NOT be available at the track.

Riders must provide their own fuel in accordance with FIM/FMB regulations.

## **9. SIGNING-ON**

5 July 2026

08:30 hrs – 09:30 hrs

Location: Race Office

Late signing-on: €50 fine or refusal to start.

## **10. RIDERS' BRIEFING**

5 July 2026 - 12:00 hrs

Location: Infield (inside of the track)

Attendance is compulsory.

---

## **11. PARADE**

Riders and machines must be ready at: 13:15 hrs

---

## **12. PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY**

10 minutes after the last heat.

Riders must attend in full race suit.

Failure to attend: €100 fine and removal from official results.

Incorrect attire: €50 fine.

## **13. PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY**

Date: 5 July 2026

Time: 18:00 hrs

Place: Race Office

Currency: Euro

#### **14. PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE**

The event is organised under the authority of FMB-BMB/ VMBB and is covered by the official federation insurance policy.

---

#### **15. PADDOCK & PIT REGULATIONS**

No rider may leave the pits, nor remove or replace any machine or engine before the conclusion of the last race, and only with permission of the Referee.

Riding in the pits:

- 1st offence: Warning
- 2nd offence: Exclusion from the meeting

Failure to use environmental mat: exclusion from practice and/or meeting.

Refusal to occupy designated pit position: exclusion.

---

#### **16. DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS**

##### **Not wearing race jacket or helmet cap:**

Exclusion from practice and/or heat.

##### **Unfair behaviour:**

a) Verbal or gestural misconduct:

€150 fine + exclusion from meeting + removal from results

b) Violent behaviour:

€250 fine + exclusion from meeting + removal from results

c) Entering Referee Tower without permission:

Immediate exclusion from meeting

##### **Alcohol use before or during practice/meeting:**

Immediate exclusion + removal from results

##### **Damage caused by rider or helper:**

Full compensation of damage + exclusion

##### **Non-appearance without valid reason:**

€50 fine + possible refusal for future events

---

#### **17. PROTESTS & APPEALS**

All protests must be lodged in accordance with the applicable FIM/FMB regulations and within the prescribed time limits.

Sanctions imposed during the meeting are immediately enforceable. Appeals may be submitted in accordance with the FIM Europe Disciplinary Code.
